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Cross Age Summer Tutoring Program

The Cross Age Tutoring Program is a summer project of the Literacy Council of Alaska. This will be the 33rd year for the program! The Cross-Age Program exists to enhance academic and personal growth in teens and elementary age students. Youth between the ages of 14 and 18 are invited to apply to participate in this summer's program as tutors.

This year, the Cross Age Tutoring program will offer a three-week session in June and a three-week session in July, from 9am to 12pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. The June session will run from June 9-26 and the July session from July 7-23. Tutors can apply for one or both. The sessions will focus on critical thinking and skills building in math and reading. Tutors this summer will be working with a standard curriculum and learning to work as cooperative teams. The curriculum will be based on Alaska Standards, Grade Level Expectations and targeted to the students' needs.

We are looking for volunteer tutors who are interested in developing leadership skills, gaining work experience, learning to build a cooperative team and helping first through third graders increase foundational skills. Upon completion of the summer program, tutors will receive letters of reference and will have made a lasting impression on the children enrolled in the program. This program is a great way to gain work experience and improve your resume for college and future job opportunities.

Once tutors have been selected, a tutor training and planning meeting will be held at the beginning of June to discuss the proposed curriculum and develop goals and guidelines for the program.

To be successful, the program needs motivated young people with strong academic skills and an ability to communicate well with peers, adults and children.
