SCHOOL AGE LITERACY PROGRAM

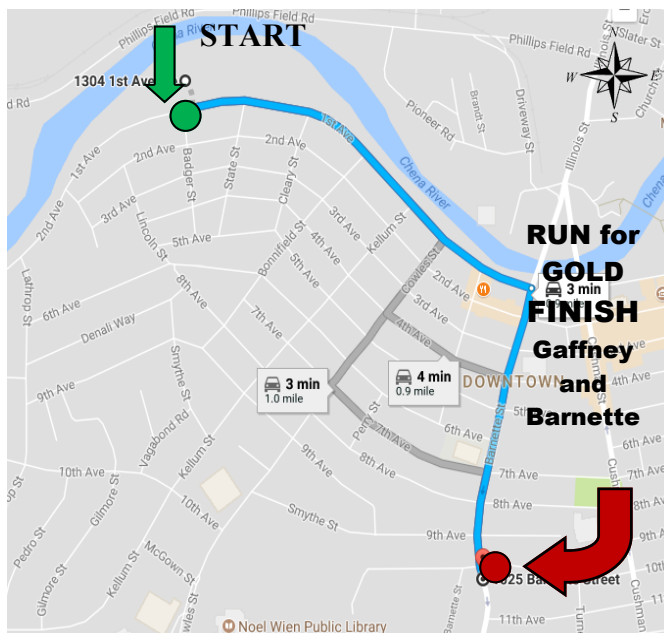
